

# TRICARE® Choices: At a Glance





TRICARE is the Department of Defense's worldwide health care program available to eligible beneficiaries from any of the seven uniformed services—the U.S. Army, U.S. Navy, U.S. Air Force, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Coast Guard, U.S. Public Health Service Commissioned Corps, and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

TRICARE Choices: At a Glance provides an overview of TRICARE's programs, including medical, pharmacy, and dental options. Eligibility for TRICARE is determined by information in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS). It is important for sponsors to keep DEERS records up to date. ## What TRICARE program options are available?

Depending on your beneficiary category and location, you may be eligible for different program options. Use the chart below to determine your available options. Additional program details are listed inside. Your options may change when you move or when you become entitled to Medicare Part A. For assistance with health care coverage when moving or traveling, contact your regional contractor.

<sup>2.</sup> ADFMs are **not** required to have Medicare Part B to remain eligible for TRICARE. Once the sponsor reaches age 65, Medicare Part B **must** be in effect no later than the sponsor's retirement date to avoid a break in TRICARE coverage.

<sup>1.</sup> Authorized providers who are not part of the TRICARE network of civilian providers may charge beneficiaries using TRICARE Standard up to 15 percent above the TRICARE-allowable charge for services. Beneficiaries are responsible for that additional 15 percent, along with applicable cost-share and deductible amounts. Note that overseas, authorized providers may be allowed to charge more than 15 percent above the TRICARE-allowable charge that applies in the United States and U.S. territories. You may learn more by contacting a TRICARE Overseas Program (TOP) Regional Call Center, TRICARE Area Office, or a TRICARE Service Center.

<sup>2.</sup> TRICARE Plus is a program that allows beneficiaries who normally are only able to get care at MTFs on a space-available basis, and who are not enrolled in a TRICARE Prime option, to enroll and receive primary care appointments at the MTF within the same primary care access standards as beneficiaries enrolled in a TRICARE Prime option.

<sup>3.</sup> If you choose to enroll in USFHP, you may not access care at military treatment facilities (MTFs), including MTF pharmacies. Additionally, you are not eligible to use the other program options listed in this brochure. If you decide to disenroll from USFHP or move out of one of its designated service areas, you regain eligibility for other TRICARE programs.

Note: Non-active duty beneficiaries may also seek care at military treatment facilities on a space-available basis.

# **Dental Options**

# **TRICARE Active Duty Dental Program**

The TRICARE Active Duty Dental Program (ADDP) is administered by United Concordia Companies, Inc. (United Concordia) and is available to eligible active duty service members (ADSMs) who are either referred for care by a dental treatment facility (DTF) to a civilian dentist or have a duty location and live greater than 50 miles from a DTF. ADSMs enrolled in TRICARE Prime Remote are automatically eligible to use the Remote ADDP. National Guard and Reserve members are eligible only if they have active duty orders issued for a period of more than 30 consecutive days.

#### **ADDP Benefits**

- Provides dental care to ADSMs who are unable to receive required care from a military DTF
- Ensures dental health and deployment readiness
- United Concordia will coordinate appointments for ADSMs:
  - Within 21 days of request for routine dental care (e.g., examinations, cleanings, fillings)
  - Within 28 days of request for specialty dental care (e.g., crowns, bridges, dentures, periodontal treatment)

# **TRICARE Dental Program**

The TRICARE Dental Program (TDP), administered by United Concordia, is available to eligible active duty family members (ADFMs) and National Guard and Reserve members and their eligible family members.

#### **TDP Benefits**

- Voluntary enrollment
- Worldwide, portable coverage
- Single and family plans available

- Affordable monthly premiums
- Lower specialty care cost-shares for E1–E4 pay grades
- Comprehensive coverage for most dental services
- 100 percent coverage for most preventive and diagnostic services

## TRICARE Retiree Dental Program

The TRICARE Retiree Dental Program (TRDP), administered by Delta Dental® of California, is available to retired service members and their eligible family members, including retired National Guard and Reserve members. Each new enrollee must fulfill an initial enrollment period of 12 consecutive months. After the initial 12-month period, you become eligible for the full scope of benefits offered under the Enhanced TRDP and will continue your enrollment in the program on a month-to-month basis. If you are a new retiree who elects to enroll within four months after your retirement from active duty or transfer to Retired Reserve status, you are eligible for a waiver of the 12-month waiting period for the full scope of benefits. Otherwise, services including crowns and onlays, bridges and partial/full dentures, implants, and orthodontics will not be covered until after the 12-month waiting period.

#### **TRDP Benefits**

- Voluntary enrollment
- Worldwide, portable coverage
- Single, dual, and family plans available
- Monthly premiums vary regionally by ZIP code; minimal deductibles and cost-shares apply
- Comprehensive coverage for most dental services; visit any dentist within the TRDP service area

# TRICARE Pharmacy Program

The TRICARE Pharmacy Program, administered by Express Scripts, Inc., provides prescription medications for all eligible beneficiaries. Costs for prescriptions are based on the category under which the drug is classified—formulary or non-formulary and generic or brand name—and where the prescription is filled: a military treatment facility (MTF) pharmacy, TRICARE

pharmacy home delivery (mail order), a TRICARE retail network pharmacy, or a non-network pharmacy. You can convert prescriptions for medications you take on a regular basis from a TRICARE retail network pharmacy to TRICARE home delivery by calling the Member Choice Center.
